School Safety Update - John Pennell

- It is a state requirement for us to have an Emergency Access Guide for local police & fire this is an internal document and cannot be shared with the community for safety reasons.
- We are required by law to have 3 different type drills every 3 years: Lock down type drill, table top, and a full blown scenario in a building.

- We have added more/better cameras to a lot of our buildings, installed electronic key fob's on most exterior doors, and have a buzz in system at all schools for visitors.
- We will be purchasing a door barrier for each interior door classroom with the help of a community member that is doing fundraising for these.
- Currently researching ballistic film that goes over the glass of doors & windows.
- Looking in to a visitor badge program that will scan an ID and print a badge with a picture.
- Will be purchasing additional cameras and electronic locks.
- This year we contracted with a retired police chief/educator to run our building safety committees in each building.
