## 5th Grade E-Learning Activities

Many students in 5th Grade use Clever to access our online programs (for example Reflex, Newsela, Freckle, Google, etc). \*To access Clever, visit <u>https://clever.com/in/springboro</u>. Students will be prompted to enter in their Google Login.

\*Students in Jung and Cane homerooms do not use Clever typically due to having a different username because of the online Math program they use. Students in Jung and Cane homerooms have the following email/username: <u>lastname.firstname@students.springboro.org</u>. These students will need to regularly check their personal student email, along with Google Classroom.

The 5th Grade team has decided each classroom teacher will post assignments for their classes/specific content areas in Google Classroom. Links to Google Classroom are included next to teacher names below. Students are comfortable using Google Classroom since this is a platform they use regularly at school, so this shouldn't be a challenge for them to use from home. However, all teachers will be available to answer questions by email if there needs to be clarification on an assignment or parents and students have questions.

\*UPDATED E-LEARNING EXPECTATIONS: After a little observation and reflection, as a school, we are going to "apply the brakes" a bit regarding our e-learning expectations. In an effort to avoid overwhelming families who are home working, sharing devices, and trying to balance everything, the elementary curriculum team has decided to scaffold our learning days.

\*Beginning Monday, March 30th, teachers in grades 2-5 will operate as follows:

- <u>Monday & Thursdays</u> Students will only have MATH instruction/assignments. This may include various videos, Google Meets, independent assignments, Reflex, Kahn, Zearn, etc.
- <u>Tuesday & Fridays</u> Students will only have <u>READING/ELA</u> instruction/assignments This may include various videos, Google Meets, independent assignments, reading, Newsela, etc.

• <u>Wednesdays</u> - Students will have <u>SPECIAL</u> area instruction/ assignments, and our 5th grade students will also have <u>SCIENCE</u> instruction/assignments on Wednesdays.

**\*\*\*Note Regarding Specials:** On Wednesdays, students should choose 2-4 activities to complete for special area classes (no less than 2). Ideally, they will select one activity per special class (art, music, PE, technology). Five Points students will have 2 art classes this quarter and will only be required to complete 1 assignment for art.
