

Ways to Play on a Snow Day!

Cut plastic straws for scissor practice! String the straw pieces onto yarn for pretty necklaces or bracelets.

Write a letter or draw a picture for a special person and send it in the mail! Maybe you will get one in return!

Make sparkly snow paint with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup each of flour, salt and water. Apply to a piece of heavy paper or cardboard with a spoon, craft stick or squeeze bottle. It will sparkle as it dries!

Pour and mix colored water. Set out cups and small pitchers with colored water. Experiment with mixing and creating new colors. Muffin tins and pipettes work well too.

Try batting balloons around the room using your head, elbows, knees, or nose. Can you bat a balloon back and forth with a fly swatter?
