## **Our Story – Part 2**

SPRINGBORO, Ohio – Last week I talked about some of the great things that are happening at Springboro Community City Schools. This week I have another story to share.

The Miami Valley Hospital project continues to confuse people. For the naming rights to the football stadium, Miami Valley and Premier Health partners provided funds to place artificial turf on the football field, resurface the track and provide additional seating on the home and visitors side.

The medical building we are building is also a Miami Valley Hospital/Premier Health Partners project. This 40,000 sq. ft. building will house our students' locker rooms, coaches' offices, and weight training facility on the first floor. The second and third floors will be rented to physicians. Part of the third floor facing the stadium will include a new press box. The school district borrowed the money on a 22 year loan. Miami Valley signed a contract to lease the second and third floor of the building for 22 years. The lease by Miami Valley will pay back the loan and the interest on the loan. In 22 years, the building will be totally paid off, belong to Springboro Schools, will be available for new rentals, and will have cost the taxpayers nothing.
