District COVID-19 Update

- Andrea Cook (Assistant Superintendent of Instruction), Larry Hook (Superintendent)
 - Andrea Cook discussed the state of the district as it relates to curriculum, and the current Model A and Model B options being offered.
 - Ms. Cook addressed areas of need and areas of success involving the students and staff both in-person and at-home learning, as well as speaking to the district's technology efforts and improvements.
 - Larry Hook spoke on the current state of the district as a whole during the 2020-2021 school year, as well as the district's current 5-year forecast and the financial outlook of Springboro Schools.

Questions

- Several COVID-19 related questions were posed:
 - What can be done about assignments being posted after the school day for Model B students, as students/parents feel the need to complete the assignments right, which creates a long work day?
 - Assignments have a 24-hour deadline from the time they are posted (weekends excluded).
 - Is there thought to use what the district is doing for Model A and Model B once the COVID-19 pandemic is behind us?
 - While we are uncertain of when the COVID-19 pandemic will subside, there are no plans to offer an at-home/virtual option, should the COVID-19 pandemic go away. As of now, the district is planning for a traditional school year to begin the 2021-2022 school year. However, we will continue to work with the State and County Health Depts., and monitor if our current Model A and Model B options should remain.
