## **SPRINGBORO JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

2024-2025 COURSE REQUESTS | 7TH GRADE

The 2024-2025 school year will consist of 6 instructional periods. All students will take one class in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies for the entire school year. **Placement in these academic areas will be determined by nationally-normed assessment results.**

### **REQUIRED CLASSES**

Springboro Junior High students are required to take one quarter of each of the following classes in 7th or 8th grade:

*Health   Physical Education   Fine Arts (Art or Music)   Careers & Consumer Concepts*

### **INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE**

*International Language classes are **optional** - They are high school level courses.*

Students may take the first level of an international language in 7th or 8th grade. The prerequisite for the first language class is an 80% in English Language Arts during the previous school year. The prerequisite for the second level is an 85% in the first level class taken in the 7th grade. **The grades for these courses will appear on the student's high school transcript. International language courses must be taken in consecutive school years.** There is also a quarter long exploratory class that can be taken in 7th grade only. The grade for the class **will not** appear on the high school transcript.

French I & Spanish I are a full year commitment. Drops after the first quarter will not be allowed.

If a student intends to take Band, Strings, or Choir in both 7th and 8th grade in addition to a year long International Language class, they will need to take the required elective classes in 7th grade and the first language class in 8th grade.

### **BAND, STRINGS, CHOIR**

Band, Strings and Symphonic Choir require previous participation or an audition. Choir is open to any student who wishes to participate. These classes are a full year commitment and include events outside of the regular school day. Drops after the first quarter drop week will not be allowed.

### **ELECTIVE COURSES**

On the back of this form, students will need to select 8 first choice elective courses. There is also a space to include 4 alternate courses. **Every effort will be made to get your student into their chosen classes. If a conflict arises, priority will be given to the academic classes over the electives.**
