INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE

International Language classes are optional - They are high school level courses.

Students may take the first level of an international language in 7th or 8th grade. The prerequisite for the first language class is an 80% in English Language Arts during the previous school year. The prerequisite for the second level is an 85% in the first level class taken in the 7th grade. **The grades for these courses will appear on the student's high school transcript. International language courses must be taken in consecutive school years.**

These classes are a full year commitment. Drops after the first quarter will not be allowed.

BAND, STRINGS, CHOIR

Band, Strings and Symphonic Choir require previous participation and/or an audition. Choir is open to any student who wishes to participate. These classes are a full year commitment and include events outside of the regular school day. Drops after the first quarter drop week will not be allowed.
