## Elective Program of Studies



## $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Schedule

$\square$ Six instructional periods

- Four core classes
- 2 additional periods (electives/study hall)
$\square$ Art, Health, PE, Music, PLTW (Pre-Engineering), Computer, Careers and Consumer Concepts, and International Language
- Courses are one quarter, one semester, or one full year


## Core Class Scheduling

You will be placed in your core classes based on the classes you take in 6th grade and nationally-normed assessment results, i.e. IAAT, MAP, etc.

For example- Core will move to core, enriched to enriched, Pre-Algebra goes to Algebra, etc.

Our gifted specialist Mandie Barger will be in contact with any student eligible for acceleration.

## Required Electives

$\square$ Students are required to take one quarter of each of the following courses before the end of $8^{\text {th }}$ grade.
$\square$ Physical Education
$\square$ Health
$\square$ Careers and Consumer Concepts
$\square$ A Fine Arts Course (Music or Art)

## Optional Elective Courses

$\square$ Fine Arts - Music or Art
$\square$ Physical Education/Gym
$\square$ Computer
$\square$ STEM/Project Lead The Way
$\square$ International Language

## Fine Arts Courses


$\square$ Band, Strings, Choir and Symphonic Choir (audition) are year-long courses
$\square$ World Music is a semester course
$\square$ Art (all classes are quarter-long)

- Visual Arts
- Careers in Art (1 and 2)
- Studio Art (1 and 2)

One fine arts class is required in either $7^{\text {th }}$ or $8^{\text {th }}$ grade

## Physical Education (PE or Gym)


$\square$ One quarter of Physical Education is required but it may be taken for:
$\square$ One quarter

- One semester
$\square$ Three quarters
- An entire year

One PE class is required in either $7^{\text {th }}$ or $8^{\text {th }}$ grade

## Computer Courses

$\square$ Careers and Computer Concepts (required: 1/4)
$\square$ Computer Applications (1/4)
$\square$ Computer Coding (1/4)
$\square$ Digital Media (1/4)
$\square$ Video Production (1/2)

The Careers class is required in either $7^{\text {th }}$ or $8^{\text {th }}$ grade. All other computer classes are not required.

## PLTW Electives (STEM)

- App Creators
- Architectural Design
- Automation and Robotics I
- Automation and Robotics II*

Computer Science for Innovators and Makers

- Design and Modeling
- Flight and Space
- Energy Detectives
- Medical Detectives

All courses are quarter-long and none are required. Automation and Robotics II* has a prerequisite.


## International Language Courses

$\square$ These are high school level classes
$\square$ French and Spanish are offered
$\square$ May be taken $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade (Level $1 \& 2$ ) or ONLY $8^{\text {th }}$ grade (Level 1)
$\square$ May not skip a year between classes
$\square$ These courses are for high school credit and WILL appear on the student's high school transcript

Level 1 - Must have an 80\% in ELA to qualify. Level 2 - Must have an 85\% in Level 1 to qualify.

Courses are a year-long and are not required.

## International Language Courses

$\square$ Exploratory Class for $7^{\text {th }}$ graders only
$\square$ French and Spanish are both offered
$\square$ These courses are NOT for high school credit and WILL NOT appear on the student's high school transcript
$\square$ All $7^{\text {th }}$ graders are eligible to take $\square$ NO grade qualifications are required

Courses are a quarter-long and are not required.



## What to Schedule?

## Students are asked to select enough elective classes to fill 2 class periods for ONLY the $7^{\text {th }}$ grade.

This could include 8 quarter-long classes, 4 semester-long classes, or 2 year-long classes. It could also be a combination of quarter, semester and year-long classes - enough to fill 2 periods.

## $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Immunizations

$\square$ Immunization record:

- Diphtheria, pertussis, and tetanus (Tdap) booster (given no sooner than the child's $10^{\text {th }}$ birthday)
- First dose of the Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine
$\square$ OR Immunization Exemption Letter
- Information and the exemption letter is on www.Springboro.org link under the health forms

## $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Immunizations - Review

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PLEASE PROVIDE AN UPDATED VACCINE RECORD TO THE SCHOOL as Verification that your child has had the Tdap Booster and the \(1^{\text {st }}\) Meningococcal (MCV4) Vaccine.
The updates Immunization record can be sent to:
immunizations7@springboro.org
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If you choose not to immunize your child, then an Exemption Letter must be completed. This can be found on the district website. Exemption must be dated after July $1^{\text {st }}, 2023$.

Low cost immunizations are available through the Warren County Health Department. You can call them at 513-695-2097.

## IMPORTANT: Students will not receive their class schedule in August without updated immunization information on file.
