The 2022-23 school year will consist of 6 instructional periods. All students will take one class in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies for the entire year. Placement in core subject areas will be determined by nationally-normed assessment results.

INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE

INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE CLASSES ARE OPTIONAL – THEY ARE HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES

Students may take the first level of an international language class in 7th or 8th grade. The prerequisite for the first language class is an 80% in ELA the previous year. **These are optional high school courses and the grades will appear on the student's high school transcript.** If a student intends to take band, strings or a choir class in both 7th and 8th grade and they would like to take an international language, they will take the required elective classes in 7th grade and the international language class in 8th grade. **International language classes must be taken in consecutive years.**
