

SPRINGBORO COMMUNITY CITY SCHOOLS STUDENT HEALTH INFORMATION

Revised 2-1-2016



Ohio Department of Health mandates the immunizations necessary for students attending school in Ohio. Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine is a **NEW** required vaccine for students attending Ohio schools starting in the fall of 2016. This updated information impacts our current 11th Grade Students.

- **2 Doses** of the meningococcal vaccine must be administered **prior to entry of Grade 12**. The recommended MCV4 minimum interval is at least 8 weeks between dose one (1) and dose two (2). If the first (1st) dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th Birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.

If you choose not to immunize your child, then an Exemption Letter must be completed. This can be found on the district website.

PLEASE PROVIDE AN UPDATED VACCINE RECORD TO THE SCHOOL as Verification of that your child has received the 2 Doses of the Meningococcal (MCV4) Vaccine.
